### Series History vs. VCU

Tonight's contest is only the second-ever meeting between Longwood and VCU in men's basketball. The Rams lead the young series 1-0 after a 91-80 win past the Lancers last December 22 in Richmond at the Siegel Center. In that game, Longwood fell behind 15-0 at the start before rallying back to within 85-75 with just over three minutes remaining. The Lancers had four players reach double-figure scoring as Kirk Williams posted 17 points and seven rebounds off the bench while Dana Smith added 16 points and six rebounds. VCU placed five players in double-figure scoring, led by B.A. Walker's game-high 22 points while Jamal Shuler added 17 points off the bench.

### Against CAA Schools

Longwood is 1-6 against Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) opponents, including games previously played Hofstra (0-1), James Madison (1-1), Old Dominion (0-1), VCU (0-1), and William and Mary (0-2). The Lancers are 1-2 in home games against a CAA member after a 77-73 victory past visiting JMU last February 18, the most-recent to visit Willett Hall.

### Head Coach Mike Gillian

Mike Gillian was named the seventh men's basketball head coach at Longwood on May 2, 2003. Prior to his arrival, he had been an assistant coach for Jim Larranaga at CAA member George Mason for six years (1997-2003) after a year with Coach Larranaga at Bowling Green State (1996-97). Coach Gillian is 17-72 at Longwood, including last year's record of 10-20 that tied for the seventh-best turnaround season in Division I.

### VCU Opens Anthony Grant Era

VCU is coached by first-year head coach Anthony Grant who was the top assistant coach at the defending National Champion University of Florida for the past 10 years. The Rams finished 19-10 a year ago, including an 11-7 record in the CAA, and are led by returning senior starters B.A. Walker (11.7 points) and Jesse Pellot-Rosa (9.2 points).

### Lancers Open Season With Home Win

Longwood opened its 2006-07 campaign with a 71-49 home victory past visiting Virginia-Wise Saturday afternoon. Maurice Sumter led the Lancers with a game-high 19 points while classmate Clayton Morgan added a double-double of 14 points and a game-high 13 rebounds. Longwood battled through a sluggish first half to lead 31-24 at the intermission behind 14 first-half points from Sumter. The Lancers took control in the second half, taking a 42-32 lead at 15:10 as Kirk Williams scored eight quick points, including a monstrous dunk on the back-side lob pass from Brandon Giles who finished with five assists. Longwood extended the lead to 20 points at 58-38 with 9:10 left as Morgan tallied 10 points, including an old-fashioned three-point play down low during the 16-6 run. Sumter finished with a game-high 19 points, adding a game-high six assists as well along with five rebounds and five steals. Morgan earned his seventh career double-double with 14 points and a game-high 13 rebounds, while Williams had 10 points off the bench. The Lancers shot 47% (26-55) from the field, including 54% (14-24) after the break, 21% (3-14) on three-point field goals, and 70% (16-23) at the free throw line. Longwood took a 40-26 advantage in rebounds, and forced 19 turnovers.

### Continuing Where They Left Off

Longwood is looking to begin this season as it ended last season: playing very well. The Lancers were strong down the stretch with seven wins over the final 11 games, including six wins in the last seven home games in Willett Hall where the program was 8-4 overall a year ago. Overall, Longwood lost eight games by 10 points or less, including one in overtime, while three of the losses were by three points or less.

**Veteran Line-Up**

Longwood returns all five starters among 10 returning lettermen from a year ago, including the top six scorers overall who combined for 79 percent (1,740 of 2,194 points) of the team's offense. Additionally, seven players return who played at least 18 minutes per game, averaging 26.6 minutes among them overall. Each of the seven averaged at least 7.0 points per game, including three double-figure scorers. The returning starters include seniors Maurice Sumter and Clayton Morgan, along with juniors Lamar Barrett, Brandon Giles, and Dana Smith.

**Experienced Bench Depth**

The other five returning lettermen from last season include seniors Michael Jefferson and Husein Pistoljevic as well as sophomore Kirk Williams. A pair of senior walk-on team members return as well in Darren Holmes and Joel Rowe.

**Sumter Garners Preseason Accolades**

Maurice Sumter (2005-06: 15.5 points, 5.4 rebounds) received numerous preseason accolades from various college basketball publications. A starter in all 88 games of his career, he averaged 19.2 points over the final 12 games of last season (50.3% FG). Sumter's preseason accolades include Division I Independent Player of the Year by USA TODAY Sports Weekly College Basketball Preview, Division I Independent's 'Best NBA Prospect', 'Best Defender', and All-Independent 1st-Team by *Lindy's College Basketball 2006-07*, and the All-Independent Team by *Street & Smith's College Basketball 2006-07 Yearbook*.

**Morgan Also Earns Preseason Recognition**

Clayton Morgan (2005-06: 12.3 points, 8.6 rebounds) averaged 16.0 points over the final 13 games of last season (49.3% FG), and has also received preseason recognition -- named Division I Independent's 'Best Rebounder' and All-Independent 2nd-Team by *Lindy's College Basketball 2006-07*.

### Closing In On Three-Point Record

Husein Pistoljevic (2005-06: 3.3 points, 22 3FG) enters his final season with 154 career three-point field goals to rank third all-time at Longwood. He only needs four treys to surpass J.B. Neill (1991-95, 157) for second all-time, and just 14 three-pointers to supplant career leader DeVonne Johnson (1992-96, 167). Pistoljevic already holds the single-game record for three-point field goals, making nine against Virginia Union on February 5, 2004; also a Willett Hall record.

### Day In, Day Out

Lamar Barrett (2005-06: 7.0 points, 4.0 rebounds), like Maurice Sumter, has started every game of his career (62). A former *Street & Smith's* high school All-American, he has enjoyed two solid seasons at Longwood while posting 513 points (8.4) and 271 rebounds (4.4). Barrett was a Division I Independent All-Newcomer Team selection after his freshman campaign.

### Ironman II

Brandon Giles (2005-06: 4.4 points, 3.3 assists) averaged 35.6 minutes over the final 13 games of last season, including all 45 minutes of a 93-90 overtime win past Hartford on January 28 in Willett Hall. He also averaged 4.6 assists during this late stretch of the campaign with a career-high eight assists in the Hartford contest. Giles led the team in assists (98), and posted a career-high 21 points against James Madison (Feb. 18) – a perfect 5-5 from three-point territory.

### Hot At The End

Dana Smith (2005-06: 9.6 points, 4.7 rebounds) finished last season on a roll, averaging 13.4 points and 6.1 rebounds over the final nine games. He posted a career-high 21 points against Utah Valley (March 4) in the season finale, and grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds against Savannah State (Feb. 25). Smith started the final 13 games of the year and finished second on the team in dunks (11).

### Highlights At Eleven

Kirk Williams (2005-06: 7.6 points, 4.1 rebounds) electrified crowds a year ago with his high-octane play that produced several spectacular dunks. In fact, he led the team with his 14 flushes last season that included especially-memorable slams against Liberty (Nov. 30), #4 Villanova (Dec. 10) in Atlantic City's Boardwalk Hall, and at VCU (Dec. 22). Williams also led the team in field goal percentage (.569, 87-153), including a remarkable 73.3% (33-45) over the final 13 games.

### Paging Dr. Rowe

Joel Rowe is an outstanding student at Longwood, compiling a remarkable 3.968 GPA while majoring in biology with a minor in psychology. This past summer, he served an undergraduate research fellowship at the MAYO Clinic in Jacksonville, Florida; assisting in the Neuropathology Lab. The Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship (S.U.R.F) program was composed of college students from schools across the United States, including Harvard, Cornell, Texas, Notre Dame, and Florida. Rowe presented 'A quantitative study of leukoaraiosis' to the Mayo faculty (both MD's and PhD's) at the conclusion of his fellowship. He is a two-time Division I Independent All-Academic Team honoree.

### Basketball's His Game But Football's In His Blood

Danny Wilson is one of nine children in his family, including six brothers and two sisters. Three older brothers played or play Division I football: Amos Jr. at New Mexico and Everett at North Carolina A&T, while older brother Jacob currently plays at Western Carolina. A younger brother, C.J., currently plays at East Carolina. Amos Jr. is now playing professionally with the Johnstown (Pa.) RiverHawks of the American Indoor Football

League (AIFL). A junior transfer, Wilson (6-8) is looking to make his mark in college basketball. He averaged 12.2 points (58% FG) and 9.1 rebounds last season at NJCAA Division I Louisburg (N.C.).

### Like Father, Like Son

Billy Robinson Jr. is a second-generation college basketball player. His father, Billy Sr., played collegiately at Northern Illinois (1982-84). Billy Jr. averaged 12.1 points, 10.2 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks as a senior at Hammond (Md.) High School.

### Win, Win, Win

Kevin Swecker helped his Mount Saint Joseph high school team to a record of 38-1 last year. The third-team All-Baltimore Catholic League selection averaged 10.5 points and was one of five starters who earned Division I scholarships. Mount Saint Joseph's 38 wins were a new Maryland high school record, and the program was ranked among the Top Ten in the final USA TODAY national high school rankings.

### Not Again – Injury Plagues Jefferson

Michael Jefferson (2005-06: 12.8 points) is out of action until at least December with a foot injury suffered during preseason conditioning in September. He also missed 15 games last season due to ankle and groin injuries.

### 2,184 Career Points

Maurice Sumter (1,106) and Michael Jefferson (1,078) have combined to score 2,184 points during their three-plus years together at Longwood. The pair has also totaled 812 rebounds (Sumter, 493; Jefferson, 319) while combining to start 161 games (Sumter, 88; Jefferson, 73) between them as well. Sumter ranks 12th all-time in scoring for the Lancers while Jefferson not too far behind in 14th.

### The Three-Point Stat

Longwood has made at least one three-point field goal in 115 consecutive games dating back to Nov. 26, 2002 (at Lenoir-Rhyne, W 72-68). The streak includes a high of 13 three-pointers against Virginia Union (Feb. 5, 2004) and a low of one trey on five occasions.

### Senior Captains

Maurice Sumter and Husein Pistoljevic are serving as team captains this year, as named by Coach Gillian. Both seniors, Sumter is a captain for the third-straight year while Pistoljevic is a captain for the second consecutive season.

### Las Vegas Classic Déjà vu

Longwood will participate in the exempt four-game Findlay Toyota Las Vegas Classic December 17-23 as the Lancers compete in this prestigious event for the second time in three years. The first two games of the tournament are on the road at New Mexico on December 17 at 8 p.m., and at Southern California on December 19 at 10:30 p.m.; before playing two games in Las Vegas at the Orleans Arena against Charleston Southern on December 22 at 3 p.m. and either Kennesaw State or Maryland-Eastern Shore on December 23 at either 3 p.m. or 5:30 p.m..

### First-Time Opponents

Longwood is scheduled to meet 11 opponents for the first-time ever in men's basketball this season. They include George Washington (Nov. 17), American (Dec. 4, Dec. 30), New Mexico (Dec. 17), Southern California (Dec. 19), Charleston Southern (Dec. 22), Kennesaw State or UMES (Dec. 23), Providence (Jan. 2), NJIT (Jan. 10, Feb. 19), Oklahoma (Jan. 30), Morgan State (Feb. 3), Florida Atlantic (Feb. 6), and Campbell (Feb. 22).

### Historic, Significant, & New Venues

Longwood will play in both historic and new venues this season as the Lancers play road games at New Mexico, Southern California, Providence, Oklahoma, and Virginia. The five venues, in order, include The Pit in Albuquerque (18,018), the brand new Galen Center in Los Angeles (10,258), the Dunkin' Donuts Center in Providence (12,993), the Lloyd Noble Center in Norman (12,000), and the brand new John Paul Jones Arena in Charlottesville (15,219). Don't forget the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas (7,165).

### Don't Forget The Toothbrush

Longwood will play 19 of 31 games away from Farmville this season, including 17 road games and two neutral-site contests. Included among this year's team travel plans are a nine-day trip, and a 16-day trip away from campus. The 'short' trip covers the four-game Findlay Toyota Las Vegas Classic from December 16-24, while the 'long' trip also covers four games: Providence, Yale, NJIT, and Utah Valley State from January 1-16. The Lancers also have three-day trips to both Oklahoma Jan. 29-31, and to Campbell and Savannah State February 22-24. Fortunately, there are also eight same-day trips for games at Norfolk State (Nov. 15), George Washington (Nov. 17), Richmond (Nov. 20), North Carolina A&T (Nov. 28), American (Dec. 4), High Point (Dec. 6), Liberty (Dec. 9), and Virginia (Feb. 13).
