Series History

Longwood and Southeast Missouri State are meeting for the first-time ever in the sport of men's basketball. It is also the Lancers first-ever game against a member of the Ohio Valley Conference.

Head Coach Mike Gillian

Mike Gillian (North Adams State '86) was named the seventh men's basketball head coach at Longwood on May 2, 2003. Prior to his arrival, he had been an assistant coach for Jim Larranaga at George Mason for six years (1997-2003) after a year with Coach Larranaga at Bowling Green State (1996-97). Coach Gillian is 27-98 at Longwood, including 2-4 this season and 9-22 last year, while following a record of 10-20 during 2005-06 that tied for the seventh-best turnaround year in Division I that year.

A Look At Southeast Missouri State

Southeast Missouri State (enrollment of 10,665) is 2-3 after a 102-99 double-overtime loss to Coppin State yesterday at the Sears Centre Arena during its third game of the <u>Chicago Invitational Challenge</u>. The Redhawks were led by Jimmy Drew with 19 points, including 6-8 three-pointers, while Will Bogan (6-10, 300) added 15 points and 12 rebounds, and Calvin Williams (6-8, 215) had 11 points and 10 rebounds. SEMO lost leads of 14 points in the second half, and eight points in the first extra period en route to the three-point loss to the Eagles. Southeast Missouri State has eight (8) players on its roster that have transferred-in from other two-year or four-year schools.

A Look At Longwood

Longwood (enrollment of 4,500) is 2-4 after an 80-65 loss to UNC Wilmington yesterday at the Sears Centre Arena in its third game of the <u>Chicago Invitational Challenge</u>. The Lancers were led by Kirk Williams who scored a game-high 26 points, including 4-9 on three-point field goals, adding a career-high five steals. Dana Smith had 15 points and six rebounds for the Lancers. LU shot 31% (20-64) from the field, including 36% (9-25) on three-point field goals, and 62% (16-26) at the free throw line. Longwood battled back from a 43-25 halftime deficit to within 66-59 with 5:16 remaining but could get no closer against the Seahawks. The Lancers did out-rebound the taller opponents 35-31, including 23 at the offensive end.

It's Official!

Longwood University is competing this year as one of three new members to NCAA Division I. The Lancers, along with UC Davis and Northern Colorado, have full certification and eligibility during 2007-08 after completing their four-year reclassification period during 2006-07. Longwood began operating under all Division I rules and regulations in September 2004, year two of the transition from Division II, and following an earlier one-year 'exploratory period' (2002-03). This year, the Lancers are playing a complete Division I schedule for the fourth consecutive season. Among its peer reclassification class, Longwood compiled a 20-72 record (.217) over the last three seasons, along with UC Davis (24-60, .286) and Northern Colorado (17-69, .198).

Chicago Invitational Challenge

Longwood is participating in the exempt four-game <u>2007 Chicago Invitational Challenge</u> November 18-24. The first two games of the event are on the road at #8 Indiana (Nov. 18), and at Kent State (Nov. 20); before playing two games in Hoffman Estates, Illinois at the Sears Centre Arena against UNC Wilmington (Nov. 23) and against Southeast Missouri State (Nov. 24). Also playing in the event are Coppin State, Illinois State, and Xavier.

First-Ever National TV Appearance

Longwood made its first-ever appearance on national television when playing at #8 Indiana November 18. The Big Ten Network (BTN) televised the Lancers' first-round game of the <u>Chicago Invitational Challenge</u>. The network, launched in August, is available nationwide on both DIRECTV (channel 220) and the DISH Network (channel 439) as well as over 120 cable providers nationwide with more cable operators adding weekly. LU has played on regional TV two times during the reclassification: versus #17 Cincinnati in Las Vegas during 2004-05 (Fox Sports Ohio) and at Nebraska to open 2005-06 (Fox Sports Midwest) along with local cable broadcasts at VCU (2005-06), at Liberty (2005-06, 2006-07), at IPFW (2005-06), and at Utah Valley (2004-05, 2006-07).

Senior Captains

Lamar Barrett and Brandon Giles were named team captains by head coach Mike Gillian for 2007-08, the first year that each is serving in this team leadership role. The duo are each fourth-year team members and have combined to start 151 of 196 career games (.770). "LB" and "BG" are among three players from Coach Gillian's second recruiting class at Longwood.

Playing Nationally-Ranked Opponents

Longwood played its fifth nationally-ranked opponent in four seasons at #8 Indiana (L 100-49) November 18. The Lancers have taken to the hardwood against ranked teams at Illinois (#1, 2004-05, L 105-79), versus Villanova in Atlantic City (#4, 2005-06, L 90-77), at Wake Forest (#6, 2004-05, L 88-47), and versus Cincinnati in Las Vegas (#17, 2004-05, L 95-69). Longwood also played at Southern California last December 19 (L 83-53), though before the Trojans had moved into the national polls. This year's schedule also includes Virginia, VCU, Boston College, and Kent State – each programs that could earn rankings this season.

Playing The Commonwealth

Longwood will play nine games this season against eight schools located within the Commonwealth of Virginia. The Lancers once-again have a home-and-home series against Liberty, in addition to games against Virginia, VCU, James Madison, and Norfolk State as well as non-Division I state schools Southern Virginia, Virginia Intermont, and Virginia-Wise. Longwood has an overall record of 26-16 (.619) against these eight programs, though has yet to earn a win against either Virginia (0-2) or VCU (0-2) while playing Virginia Intermont for the first time.

On The Road Again

Longwood plays 19 games away from Farmville this season, including 17 true road contests, and two neutral-site games. The Lancers have played 57 games (5-52, .088) away from home over the past three seasons, including 10 neutral-site contests – compiling a record of 2-45 (.043) in true road games and 3-7 (.300) in the neutral-site contests. Longwood has played in 20 different states and the District of Columbia during the past three years, and is scheduled to visit 10 states as well as D.C. again during 2007-08.

In The Record Books

Lamar Barrett ranks fifth in career blocks (71) at Longwood. A fourth-year starter, he has compiled 752 points (7.7) and 451 (4.6) rebounds through his first three-plus seasons and has an opportunity to become just the sixth player in school history to surpass 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. "LB" has started 96 of 98 career games for the Lancers and could also surpass the school-record for career games played (Maurice Sumter, 118, 2003-07).

In The Record Books, Too

Brandon Giles ranks fourth in career assists (290) and ninth in career three-point field goals (73) at Longwood. A third-year starter, he has also compiled 440 points (4.5) and 196 rebounds (2.0) through his first three-plus seasons. "BG" has started 55 of 98 career games for the Lancers, including 54 of his last 56 games, and he, too, could surpass the school-record for career games.

He's Back ...

Dana Smith is a fourth-year team member, though with junior-eligibility after earning a medical hardship waiver following a season-ending knee injury at Norfolk State last November 15 in the third game of the year. He has started 28 of 69 career games, including 22-straight before and after his injury early last season. Smith is back at 100% and though only six games have been played, he looks to have returned to the form he displayed at the end of 2005-06 when he averaged 13.4 points and 6.1 rebounds over the final nine games. He is averaging 12.8 points and 5.5 rebounds -- and for his career -- he has 489 points (7.1) and 276 rebounds (4.0).

Football, Anyone?

Danny Wilson is one of nine children in his family, including six brothers and two sisters. Three older brothers played Division I football: Amos Jr. at New Mexico, Everett at North Carolina A&T, and Jacob at Western Carolina. A younger brother, C.J., currently plays at East Carolina. Amos Jr. also played professionally with the Johnstown (Pa.) RiverHawks of the American Indoor Football League (AIFL). He has started each of the first five games this season and has averaged 3.3 points and 2.8 rebounds. Wilson scored a career-high 11 points against Virginia-Wise, and grabbed a career-high six rebounds at Kent State.

Dunk-Master

Kirk Williams has provided fans with plenty of highlights and thrills during his two-plus seasons with the program, throwing-down 42 dunks in 64 career games. A third-year team member, he appears poised for a big season this year after averaging career-bests of 10.2 points and 4.8 rebounds last year. Williams is averaging 19.3 points and 7.2 rebounds through six games, and has led the Lancers in field goal percentage each of the past two years as well, shooting 50% (120-240) last year after shooting 57% (87-153) two years ago.

Win, Win, Win

Kevin Swecker helped his Mount Saint Joseph high school team to a record of 38-1 during 2005-06. The third-team All-Baltimore Catholic League selection averaged 10.5 points and was one of five starters at MSJ who earned Division I scholarships. Mount Saint Joseph's 38 wins were a new Maryland high school record, and the program was ranked among the Top Ten in the final <u>USA</u> TODAY national high school rankings. He played in all 31 games last year, starting four, while averaging 4.8 points (25-31 FT, 81%) and 1.5 rebounds while making 27 three-pointers (31%, 27-88).

Like Father, Like Son

Billy Robinson Jr. is a second-generation college basketball player. His father, Billy Sr., played at Northern Illinois (1982-84). Billy Jr. played in 25 games last year and averaged 2.2 points (12-34 3FG, 35%) and 1.6 rebounds. He posted five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 FT) in the opener against Navy, and has played in each of the first six games.

High-Profile Newcomer

Ryan Bogan is a junior transfer to Longwood this year from Harcum College in Philadelphia where he scored 1,106 points in two seasons. A first-year team member, he averaged 16.2 points at Harcum while earning Region 19 Player of the Year and Tournament MVP honors last season. Bogan surpassed 1,500 career points in high school (Oxford [Pa.] Area) while earning All-State accolades, and is expected to contribute immediately, and significantly, for the Lancers. Through six games, he is averaging 10.2 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 2.2 assists while playing 28.5 minutes.

First Brazilian In Program

Beno Jaekel is a sophomore transfer and the first-ever Longwood men's basketball player from Brazil. A first-year team member, he is the second player, ironically, to join the Lancers from Western Nebraska Community College. Marek Zielinski '03 played two seasons with the program (2000-03, redshirted during 2001-02) after transferring to Longwood from Western Nebraska as well – Zielinski was originally from Poland. Jaekel has three years of eligibility after missing 2005-06 at WNCC with a knee injury. He has played in five game for the Lancers (4-5 FG, 2-2 FT).

Sophomores Slowed By Ailments

Second-year players Kevin Swecker and E.J. Dawson have yet to play this season while battling some early-season ailments. Swecker has been slowed by a bout with mononucleosis, while Dawson had arthroscopic knee surgery during preseason. The duo played in 31 games each last year with Swecker earning four starts as well -- each player is expected back in action next month.

The Three-Point Stat

Longwood has made at least one three-point field goal in 151 consecutive games that date back to November 26, 2002 (at Lenoir-Rhyne, W 72-68). The streak includes a high of 13 three-pointers against Virginia Union (Feb. 5, 2004).

First-Time Opponents

Longwood is scheduled to meet eight first-time opponents in men's basketball this season. They include #8 Indiana (Nov. 18), Kent State (Nov. 20), UNC Wilmington (Nov. 23), Southeast Missouri State (Nov. 24), Virginia Intermont (Dec. 17), Stetson (Dec. 29, Jan. 21), and Boston College (Jan. 2).

Don't Forget The Toothbrush

Longwood is playing 19 of 31 games away from Farmville this season, including 17 road games along with two neutral-site contests. Included among this year's team travel plans are an eight-day trip for the 2007 Chicago Invitational Challenge from November 17-24, the longest trip of the season to cover the games at #8 Indiana and at Kent State along with the two games in Hoffman Estates, Illinois at the Sears Centre Arena against UNC Wilmington and Southeast Missouri State. The Lancers also have two five-day trips: to Boston College and Navy January 1-5, and to Savannah State and Stetson January 18-22; and two four-day trips: to Morgan State and George Washington December 20-23, and to Florida Atlantic and Campbell February 10-13. There are two-day trips scheduled to Hofstra (Jan. 27-28) and NJIT (Feb. 3-4). MIKE GILLIAN was named the seventh men's basketball head coach in the history of Longwood University on May 2, 2003. Coach Gillian, in his fifth year during 2007-08, has built an NCAA Division I program from the ground up during his first four seasons as the school went through its four-year reclassification period from Division II. The Lancers won nine games during 2006-07 (9-22) after a 10-win season during 2005-06 (10-20) while tying for the seventh-best turnaround season in Division I (plus 9.5) that year.

Coach Gillian's four-year overall record at Longwood entering 2007-08 was 25-94. However, the Lancers are 17-30 at home in Willett Hall, including 14-10 over the past two years; led by an 8-4 record in Farmville during 2005-06. Obviously, a reclassify-

ing independent program is forced to play many games on the road as evidenced by Longwood's 5-52 record in away or neutral-site contests over the past three seasons.

Longwood will compete this year with 12 scholarship student-athletes after playing with 11 scholarships during each of the previous two seasons (2005-06, 2006-07). The Lancers finished 1-30 during 2004-05, their first year playing a full Division I schedule while competing with nine scholarships. Longwood was 5-22 during 2003-04, the first year under Coach Gillian as well as year one of the transition to Division I while competing with seven scholarships. Prior to his arrival at Longwood, Coach Gillian had been an assistant coach at George Mason University under head coach Jim Larranaga from 1997-2003. He had also worked under Larranaga for one season at Bowling Green State (Ohio) University (1996-97) before moving with him to George Mason. Gillian played a role in the recruitment of several members of the Mason team that shocked the world of college basketball during the 2005-06 season while advancing to the Final Four in Indianapolis.

Prior to joining Larranaga at BGSU, Gillian was an assistant coach at Division II American International (Mass.) from 1989-95. During that six-year stint working for current Indiana Pacers assistant coach Jimmy Powell, the Yellow Jackets went 117-58 overall with a 75-33 Northeast-10 Conference (NE-10) record, winning both the NE-10 regular season and tournament championships in 1994 (26-6). American International also advanced to the second-round of the Division II Tournament that year.

Gillian has been a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) since 1989. He was a YES Clinic speaker at the Division I Men's Final Four from 1998-2000, and again in 2007 in Atlanta, and has extensive public speaking experience through his involvement with numerous booster, local business and civic organizations, and charity events. In addition, since arriving at Longwood, Gillian has appeared on ESPN2's Cold Pizza, become a weekly in-season guest on Richmond Sports Radio 910's (formerly) The Mike Maniscalco Show, served as the same station's NCAA Tournament Analyst, co-hosted his own in-season Mike Gillian Show on Farmville's Kickin' Country 92.9, and has been interviewed by numerous sportswriters, radio personalities, and webbloggers.

Gillian was a four-year letterwinner as an undergraduate at Division III North Adams State (now the Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts), and served as a team captain during his final two years. He received a bachelor of science degree in business administration from North Adams, and earned a master of business administration degree from American International.

A native of Ayer, Massachusetts, Gillian and his wife, Janet, have a daughter, Emma (6).
